PC Tony McKeown has been holding surgeries in our mobile police station. It allows us to improve links with the community and gives residents the chance bring up any concerns they have. The surgeries take place on the first Monday in every month from 5.30pm to 7.30pm in Market Street, New Mills.

We also hold regular surgeries with students at New Mills School. This is a good way for us to build relationships with young people and to give them the chance to discuss any concerns they have. We also offer youngsters who own a mobile phone a security marking service and we provide safety advice.

We have been visiting youth groups in the area, including the Army Cadets, Little Beavers and the youth club in Longlands Road. We chatted to the youngsters about what we do, offered safety advice and a chance for them to bring up any issues or concerns.

The team continues to work on the issues of anti-social behaviour. We are patrolling the area and advising young people about the dangers of alcohol and drugs abuse and the impact it has on the local community. We are confiscating alcohol from underage drinkers and issuing fixed penalty notices to anyone caught supplying alcohol to under 18s.
